



Admission into FS1 (age 3+)

Entitlement

Once your child has had their third birthday, they are entitled to 15 hours free provision in a childcare/Education setting. The nursery hours available at The Oaks Nursery High Hazels are: -

Foundation Stage 1 Nursery

morning place (8.30-11.30) 5 mornings a week: Monday to Friday

afternoon place (12.30 – 3.30) 5 afternoons a week: Monday to Friday

Frequently Asked Questions: -

Can my child take up a school place at High Hazels if they did not attend The Oaks Nursery at High Hazels?

Yes – High Hazels work closely with other nurseries to make sure that children have a happy transition from their current setting into High Hazels Academy when they are 5. Children come to visit the reception setting and meet their new teachers in the term before their admission.

Can my child move into The Oaks at High Hazels Nursery after attending another nursery setting?

Yes, it is parental choice which nursery you put your child into. If you are considering moving nursery settings for your child, please contact the school and ask to come and visit our nursery setting. A notice period of 4 weeks will need to be given at your current nursery before you take up a place at a new nursery.

Can I choose a morning or afternoon place for my child?

We will offer you the first available place in The Oaks Nursery. This may be morning, or it may be afternoon.

The school will always work hard to try and accommodate parent needs. If (for example) you are offered a morning slot and would prefer an afternoon slot and the Nursery is full at that point, then you can choose not to take up the place temporarily and leave your child on the waiting list until an afternoon place becomes available or take up a morning place until an afternoon slot is made available. However, when nursery is full, places only open when one child leaves, so we cannot guarantee that a place will ever become available.
